The Intensive English Language Program is designed to take students from their present level of English language proficiency to a level that would permit them to successfully undertake post-secondary academic work.

Admission Requirements*

- High school diploma or equivalent or age of 19 or above
- English proficiency to be assessed on entry to the program followed by assignment of the student to the course level commensurate with their existing level of English language proficiency.

Learning Objectives*

Upon completion of this program the successful student will have reliably demonstrated the ability to:

- Understand with ease virtually everything heard or read.
- Express him/herself fluently, spontaneously, and precisely.
- Use language flexibly and effectively for social, academic and professional purposes.
- Produce clear, well-structured, detailed text on complex subjects.
- Summarize information from different spoken and written sources.
- Reconstruct arguments and accounts in a coherent presentation.

Method(s) of Evaluation*

Each 8-week course is graded as follows:

Assignments (@ 10 points per week)	80 points
Presentation	120 points
6 weekly quizzes (@50 points)	300 points
Summative Mid-term exam	200 points
Summative Final exam	300 points
Total	1000 points

Completion Requirements*

Students must attend 80% of the classes and achieve a grade of 70% in each course.
